Factors such as correct selection of components, cable sizing, protective devices and Earth bonding are all critical and should be checked prior to full testing and power-up. Any other regulations applicable to the equipment being installed such as the Machinery Directive and current health and safety legislation must also be adhered to.

All connections (including factory made) must be checked for the correct tightness prior to commissioning of the electrical installation.
All connections should also be inspected periodically to ensure correct tightness.

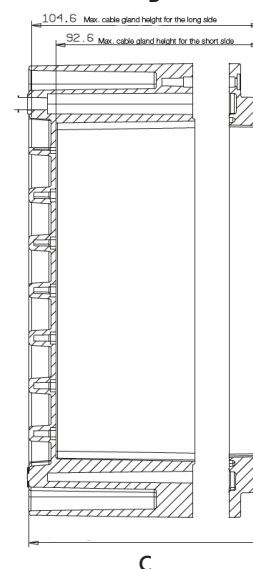
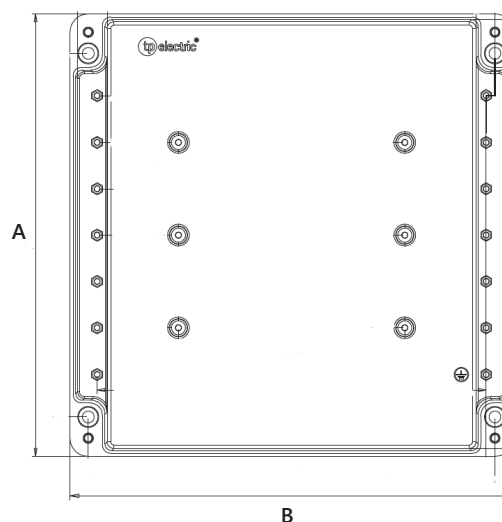
